

Cowtown Warbird Roundup 2009

Sponsor Program

The Cowtown Warbird Roundup is an annual event produced by the Fort Worth Veteran's Memorial Air Park, OV-10 Bronco Association and the Forward Air Controller's Museum in cooperation with the City of Fort Worth, Meacham International Airport and this year's co-host, Texas Aviation Services as a fund raiser for our education programs.

This fly-in is intended to provide an educational experience for our community and strives to inspire youth to pursue careers in aviation.

2009 marks the sixth fly-in of the Cowtown Warbird Roundup series. The attached flyer shows many of the events and activities planned for this year.

The producer is a non-profit 501(c) 3 corporation.

In order to cover fly in crew expenses and maximize fundraising we are offering the following three levels of sponsorship:

1. **Wingman:** \$500 - Sponsor may use an information table in the expo hangar area or an outdoor display, to market to the general public for the event, April 25th. In addition this level includes 6 tickets to the "Flight Suit" Reception and Dinner to welcome visiting crews on April 24th at the Fossil Creek Radisson Hotel. This level includes logo or mention in all Cowtown Warbird Roundup advertising and marketing.
2. **Section Leader:** \$1,000 – Same as above with an additional 2 tickets (8 total – 1 table) to the "Flight Suit" Reception and Dinner, plus access to the VIP area and refreshments during the fly in on April 25th.
3. **Division Leader:** \$2,500 – All of the above plus 8 tickets (16 total – 2 tables) for each event and status as **"Official Sponsor of the Cowtown Warbird Roundup."**

A representative of the Cowtown Warbird Roundup Committee will be glad to talk to you about this and other sponsorship programs. These levels can be modified to suit the particular desires of your organization and should be considered guidelines for sponsorship.
